Important Information With effect from 1st September 2024 the times of the school day will change. This change brings us in line with the Department for Education (DfE) expectation that all children in Y1 – Y6 will have a school week of 32.5 hours. All schools in England must have this in place from September 2024.

The DfE document, "The Length of the School Week" (July 2023) states that ...

The Government is determined that all pupils have the opportunity to achieve their full academic potential. To support this, on 28 March 2022 the Government announced, through the White Paper <u>Opportunity for all: strong schools with great teachers for your child</u>, a new minimum expectation on the length of the school week of 32.5 hours for all mainstream, state-funded schools.

So that we comply with DfE expectations the timings for the school day for all groups of learners is as follows:

The school gate will continue to be opened at 8:40 am, with entrance into class at 8:45am. The school gate will close at 8:55 am. Children who arrive after this time will be deemed to be late and will receive a "late mark".

As ever, it will be vitally important that parents and carers bring their children to school on time. Our children tell us that they feel embarrassed walking into class late because everyone else looks at them. This then affects how they feel about their learning.

We appreciate that it may take a little while to get used to the new timings but I am confident we will crack this really quickly so that all children attend school on time every day.

On Friday 28th June our Nursery and Reception children had a visit from Boo's Mobile Zoo.

The zoo brought many animals for the children to observe, hold and even pet. It was a fantastic experience, during which the children showed great curiosity and asked many questions such as "what do bearded dragons like to eat?", "Where to skunks live?"

OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL

Hermits lived on Mount Carmel near the Fountain of Elijah in northern Israel in the 12th century. They had a chapel dedicated to Our Lady. By the 13th century they became known as "Brothers of Our Lady of Mount Carmel." For centuries the Carmelites have seen themselves as specially related to Mary. Their great saints and theologians have promoted devotion to her and often championed the mystery of her Immaculate Conception.

Saint Teresa of Avila called Carmel "the Order of the Virgin." Saint John of the Cross credited Mary with saving him from drowning as a child, leading him to Carmel, and helping him escape from prison. Saint Thérèse of the Child Jesus believed that Mary cured her from illness. On her First Communion day, Thérèse dedicated her life to Mary. During the last days of her life she frequently spoke of Mary.

There is a tradition, which may not be historical, that Mary appeared to Saint Simon Stock, a leader of the Carmelites, and gave him a scapular, telling him to promote devotion to it. The scapular is a modified version of Mary's own garment. It symbolizes her special protection and calls the wearers to consecrate themselves to her in a special way. The scapular reminds us of the gospel call to prayer and penance—a call that Mary models in a splendid way. The feast day of Our Lady of Mount Carmel is celebrated on 16th July.
