Science

The Park Explorers

- Identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees.
- Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.

English

Reading: Develop skills of inference and deduction across a variety of texts.

Writing: Using the text 'Old Bear' will be writing a finding narrative and a message.

Grammar & Spelling: Focusing on capital letters and full stops.

Maths

Place Value to sort and count objects. Count forwards and backwards to 10. Represent numbers. Recognise numbers as words.

Addition & Subtraction: within 10. Introducing part-whole model. Fact families. Number bonds to 10.

History

Toys from the Past

- To sequence events of time.
- Recognise the difference/similarity between past and present in their own and others' lives
- Sort artefacts "then" and "now"

PE

Gymnastics

- Ensure movement are clear, accurate and consistent
- Prepare and perform confidently to an audience
- Safety and consistently combine six gymnastic shapes, in rolls, balances and jumps with sequences

Children explore keeping the pulse together through music and movement, by exploring their favourite things.
