Science

Plants

Children will identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants: and flowers explore the requirements of plants for life and growth, they will also investigate the way in which water is transported within plants and explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle dispersal

English

Reading: Develop skills of inference and deduction across a variety of texts. The class reader is "Goodnight Mr Fox (Roald Dahl)"

Writing: Setting narratives, information leaflets and poetry

Grammar & Spelling: Beginning to understand different word classes and advanced punctuation including ; and ()

Maths

Number: read, write, order and compare numbers up to 1000 and determine the value of each digit. Rounding numbers and decimals.

Data: sorting and classifying information
Reasoning: Use the four operations (+/ -/ x/ ÷) to solve one step problems progressing to two steps

To explore the achievements of the earliest civilisations – an overview of where and when the Ancient Egyptians appeared and an in-depth study into this civilisation

PE

Gymnastics
