RE

Domestic Church - Family: children will focus on their own family trees. They will then go onto look at the family tree of Jesus through scripture

Baptism/Confirmation: Children will explore how people can be called in different points in their lives. They will then look at the call and response made through Baptism and Confirmation

Science

States of Matter

To classify solids, liquids and gases
To know that temperature can affect solids, liquids and gases
To plan and carry out an investigation
To understand evaporation and condensation

English

Reading: Develop skills of inference and deduction across a variety of texts. The class reader is 'Mr Gum' (Andy Stanton)

Writing: Poetry and transformation narrative
Grammar & Spelling: Beginning to understand different word classes and advanced punctuation including ; and ()

Maths

Number: read, write, order and compare numbers up to 10000 and determine the value of each digit. Rounding numbers and decimals.

Data: sorting and classifying information
Reasoning: Use the four operations (+/ -/ x/ ÷) to solve one step problems progressing to two steps

History

The Roman Republic

Exploring the Roman Republic and the events that occurred during Rome's time as a republic. Children will develop a chronologically secure knowledge and understanding of history, establishing clear narratives

PE

Gymnastics

Ensure movement are clear, accurate and consistent
Prepare and perform confidently to an audience
Safety and consistently combine six gymnastic shapes, in rolls, balances and jumps with sequences

To begin to understand how to read music

Revision of conversation when meeting people, naming places and objects

Introduction to questions and answers and how to reply to simple commands
